



Dear parents/carers,

Thank to those of you who have supported your child in getting into school today. Ahead of our school closure I wanted to update you on a few further details:

Student Work

On Wednesday 24th and Thursday 25th students are expected to follow their normal timetable. In other words, they should complete the work that has been set by their five Wednesday/Thursday Week B teachers. Year 10 students can, if they wish, complete additional revision activities ahead of their Mock exams.

Teachers will be sending work to students via their school email account by 09.00am each morning and will be available to respond to any queries. We have worked with tutors this morning to establish which students may struggle to access these resources and will be providing paper copies of work.

Year 10/12 Mock Arrangements

An amended timetable for the remaining Year 10/12 Mock exams will be sent to students on Wednesday 24th June.

Free School Meals

Free school meal vouchers will be issued to eligible families by Wednesday morning. Parents/carers will receive an email/text with a link to a website – this allows them to activate the voucher and use it at their preferred shop or supermarket.

Friday 26th June

We plan to **open as normal on Friday 26th June**. Students will again be able to wear their PE/Dance kit and trainers.

I apologise if our school closure has created any inconvenience for our families. Our staff are available to support with any queries or issues that arise during the two days. I hope everyone is able to stay cool and we look forward to welcoming our students back into the building on Friday morning.
